Per the instructions during our phone conversation on September 5, 2013, I am writing to update the ISES data that was incorrectly reported for the School District of Milton when the ISES window closed.

On the Third Friday count (September 2012), ISES economically disadvantaged data that was uploaded included incorrect information. The information had not yet been fully updated to reflect all students' economically disadvantaged status as determined by free and reduced lunch.

That being said, the corrected economically disadvantaged data for students in Milton's seven schools, as well as the district, should have been reported as follows at the time of reporting:
