CTE Tasks for 21-22 SY

- **Review WISEdata Exports**

- Career Education: Certified/Non Certified
 - Review columns I-P. Do they make sense, per student?
 - Is “Certified Career Education Program” recorded at the course level or program level - There may be 2 different ways to enter in the SIS, pending course or program. Should you be seeing multiple “Location of Program’s” for “DPI Course Code?”
- Career Education: CTE Concentrators
 - Review with CTE Team the number of Concentrators and IAC reporting
 - Warning 7099 - No CTE Concentrators
 - This is the Concentrator count that flows to WISEdash for Carl Perkins.
- Career Education: CTE Participants
 - Review that all students 9-12th grade that took 1 CTE course and passed are reporting.
- Roster: Course Offerings
 - Review Column “O” - CTE Course. Do you have CTE courses correctly identified in the SIS. Each CTE Roster/State code has a non-CTE version. Make sure the CTE version is being used for CTE.
- High School Completion
 - CTE Graduate Concentrators are dependent on HSC status for 21.22 SY.

CTE Tasks for 21-22 SY

- **Review for students/courses populating**
 - If students are missing check student status in SIS:
 - [Certificated Program Status](#) - for Certified Programs (ex. Work Based Learning and Industry Recognized Credentials.)
 - Concentrator Status - must be manually approved each year, for each 11 & 12th grade student
 - Are students enrolled in courses or programs (Career Education)?
 - If using Program Association, get list of WBL or IRC from CTE teachers.
 - Does course have a Roster code or IAC if part of Perkins Career Pathway?
 - Making changes to courses and students already sent to WISE may entail a resync from the SIS
 - [Roster Work Plan](#)
- **Review data in WISEdash for District**
 - Coursework and Perkins dashboards
 - Work with CTE Team to double check Career Education (ex. WBL-YA, IRC, dual enrollment, advanced opportunities, International Baccalaureate)
 - New Work-Based Learning crosstab in the Snapshot>Technical Skills Attainment Dashboard.
