Snapshot

December 5, 2023 is the Snapshot for all 22.23 SY CTE and Career Education Data

- The Snapshot begins at the start of the business day on December 5, 2023.
- All CTE and Career Education data should be accurate in WISEdash for District before December 1, 2023. If you see it in WISEdash the day before the Snapshot, you know that the data has been sent.
- It takes time for the data to flow from your Student Information System (SIS) to WISEdata Portal and into WISEdash for District. At least 24 hours for the entire process.
- When the entire state is submitting data at the same time, the server gets slow.
- Changing data in your SIS does not automatically flow to WISE. Only new data automatically flows. Changed data calls for a resync/republish from your SIS.




Reminders

- December 5, 2023 is the Snapshot for all 22.23 SY CTE and Career Education Data.
- Data must be visible in WISEdash for District before a Snapshot.
- WISEdata Portal is live data and will change if someone updates the data. However, if changed after a Snapshot, it will not change in the Snapshot dashboards or state/federal reporting.
- A Snapshot, freezes the data and is what DPI uses for state/federal reports.
- DPI uses Perkins (CTE) data on December 6, 2023 to complete the Consolidated Annual Report. This is sent to the U.S. Department of Education per Perkins requirements.
- This data can be completed prior to June 30, 2023...encouraged to do so.
- Review Perkins dashboard in WISEdash for District to ensure your data is ready for the Snapshot.
- Data review is a team effort!
