Career Education Data Reporting

This document outlines specific data elements required for Career Education reporting. Career Education data consists of career and technical education (CTE) data and postsecondary preparation data from report cards. All public school districts are required to submit CTE course data for grades 9-12. Additional data are required for districts that receive Carl Perkins funding. Work-based Learning is collected for both Carl Perkins and report cards. It must meet the six criteria to be reported and are identified below with an asterisk.

CTE (Carl Perkins Districts)

CTE concentrator – Grades 11 and 12

- Instructional area code (IAC) represents career pathway)

Single parent – Grades 11 and 12

CTE participant – Grades 9-12
