

Subject: FW: Additional ACP Guidance

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Good afternoon,

After providing the *Use of Perkins Funds for ACP Implementation* document, we received additional questions. I believe everyone understands the unusual situation we are in now that ACP has become a State initiative. Please be patient with me as it's a learning process for me as well. I have had several additional questions that want clear parameters as to how this money can be used for the ACP Leadership Conference in November.

1. Can we use Perkins funding to support expenses related to attending the ACP Leadership Conference in November?

Answer: Yes; however we ask this be limited to licensed CTE teachers only. Counselors may be covered **if** attending **with** a CTE teacher. Non-CTE licensed staff cannot use Perkins funding to attend this.

2. I don't understand, the *Guidance for Carl Perkins Expenditures* document gives examples when non-CTE licensed staff can attend Perkins professional development together; why isn't this one of them?

Answer: The examples on the *Guidance for Carl Perkins Expenditures* document is related to academic integration. This workshop is not related to academic integration and therefore is not applicable.

3. Are there any other limitations to the expenditures? Travel, lodging, registration, and substitute teachers are all permissible?

Answer: Yes; however recall that we need to be cautious when the ACP activity is Perkins related and when it is State initiative related. We have determined that 100% of the day on Monday, November 16 is Perkins related; however only 30% of Tuesday, November 17 is Perkins related. If you are attending Tuesday, 70% of Tuesday's expenses need to be covered by local funds.
