The Hudson Board of Education has reviewed the impact of the 2015-17 biennial budget proposal on our school district and approved the attached resolution by a 6-0 vote on March 10, 2015. We ask for your consideration of budget changes that support the three recommendations identified in the resolution:

- Restoring the \$150 per pupil categorical aid in 2015-17.
- Adding an inflationary increase in state equalized aid and a corresponding increase in the revenue cap.
- No increase of public funding for the expansion of vouchers and independent charter schools.
