Title IV Part A
What School Districts Need to Know About the
Every Student Succeeds Act

- What key changes should I be aware of?* 1. Title IV, Part A, is newly authorized to provide funds “for student support and academic enrichment.”
2. There are three objectives: a) provide all students with access to a well-rounded education; b) to improve school conditions for student learning; and, c) to improve the use of technology in order to improve the academic achievement and digital literacy of all students.
- When does this go into effect?* Provisions of Title IV, Part A will go into effect for the 2017-18 school year.
- What do I have to do right now?* Review and familiarize yourself with the contents of the [Non-Regulatory Guidance - Student Support and Academic Enrichment Grants](#) provided by the U.S. Department of Education. Pay particular attention to the examples of allowable activities in consideration of how this Title might best meet your district needs.
- Is there anything I will need to do this fall?* You can begin to start considering potential relevant stakeholders for engagement in this work.
