The Wisconsin State Executive Council is composed of nine officers, elected to serve the state association and its members. Officers plan and conduct the State Leadership Conference and programming and serve as one portion of the governing body, alongside the WI FCCLA Board of Directors of the state association.

State Election Process Timeline

The application window will close at midnight on <u>Friday</u>, <u>January 12th</u>. The application is <u>linked</u> <u>here</u> and can also be found at the QR code pictured below and at the Wisconsin FCCLA DPI website (https://dpi.wi.gov).

Advancing candidates will be notified on or before January 19th.

Advisers will be asked to proctor a provided 25-question FCCLA knowledge test by the end of the school day on <u>February 3rd</u>. This test will be sent to advisers with the notification received on or before January 19th that their member has advanced in order to provide advisers ample time to proctor the test.

Following the close of the testing window, interviews will be scheduled. All interviews will be held using an online platform. The date for interviews is yet to be determined and will be based on candidate and panel availability.

Interviews will be approximately 25 minutes in length and include a 3 minute speech that will be presented directly to the panel during that time.

The prompt for the speech will be: <u>Describe how involvement in FCCLA helps to prepare participants for success in the current world.</u>

At the conclusion of interviews, all positions, aside from First Vice President and President will be selected and a notification will follow within the week. The roles of First Vice President and President will be determined at SLC (April 8-10) where candidates will give speeches and voting delegates will participate in a ballot election.
