Collection of this information is a requirement of Wis. Stats. §115.385(3).

All private schools participating in a PSCP will receive a Private School – Choice Students Report Card. A Private School – Choice Students Report Card means a report card issued under §115.385(3), Wis. Stats., for choice students at the private school.

All private schools participating in a PSCP can additionally opt to have a Private School – All Student Report Card. A Private School – All Student Report Card means a report card issued under §115.385(3), Wis. Stats., for all students, choice and nonchoice, at the private school.

A private school participating in a program under §§118.60 or 119.23, Wis. Stats., that opts to receive a Private School – All Student Report Card agrees to all of the following:

- The school will assign all students in the school a unique identifier, called a WISEid, which will be used in the DPI's data collection system.
- The school will administer, pay for, and submit performance and participation results for all nonchoice students for all state required assessments regardless if the school has Choice students in that grade. Parents may opt their child(ren) out of the state required assessment as provided by state law.
- The school will submit to the DPI student-level data elements needed to produce a Private School All Students Report Card such as enrollment, attendance, high school completion (if applicable), dropout, and student demographic data for all students.
- The school will need to submit a minimum of two consecutive years of data for its nonchoice students before a Private School All Students Report Card will be issued. The DPI will issue a Private School – All Students Report Card if there is sufficient data to calculate a score.
- The school will inform all the parents of nonchoice students that the school has opted to have a Private School All Students Report Card and that student-level data for nonchoice students will be submitted to the DPI for report card purposes.
- Schools with any pupils in grades 9-12 agree to the following:
  - The school grants permission to, and directs ACT to provide, any and all of the School's ACT assessments data to the DPI. ACT
    may provide access and reports to the DPI on multiple levels including system level, school level, class level, and individual student
    level.
  - 2. The ACT data is being provided to the DPI for the sole purpose of producing a private school report card, as authorized by Wis. Stat. 115.385(3)(b).
  - 3. School will indemnify and hold ACT, its employees, contractors, and agents, harmless from any and all loss, damage, injury, or liability arising directly out of this grant of permission, including failure to deliver any required information within the prescribed time period provided such delay is not due to ACT; or the disclosure of user personally identifiable information or data of the School to the DPI pursuant to this permission.
  - 4. The school understands that ACT has its own data privacy protocol, which ACT will use to keep student data confidential outside of this agreement.
  - The school understands that it retains the right to all data from its ACT assessments and that this request does not in any way waive its rights to the data.
