

STUDENT PLACEMENT DISPUTE FORM
McKinney Vento Homeless Education Assistance Act



A homeless child or youth has the right to remain at his or her school or origin (public school that the child attended when permanently housed, or the public school in which the child was last enrolled) or to attend the school located in the area that they are currently residing. If the student is eligible to attend more than one school, parents/caregivers or unaccompanied youth will have the option of choosing the school.

When a dispute arises over school placement, this form is to be completed by the parent/caregiver or unaccompanied youth. The Homeless Coordinator or building social worker can provide assistance to the parent/caregiver or unaccompanied youth to complete this form.
