

Wisconsin Future Ready State Report – Consolidated Report

As of June 30th, 2017

The state of Wisconsin uses the Future Ready Assessment to gauge the readiness of its districts for digital learning.

The purpose of the Future Ready framework is to determine the digital learning readiness of a district to begin successful implementation in schools and classrooms. To that end, the Future Ready assessments analyze digital learning readiness based on seven interdependent gears, plus leadership. Those include:

- Curriculum, Instruction, and Assessment
- Use of Space and Time
- Robust Infrastructure
- Data and Privacy
- Community Partnerships
- Personalized Professional Learning
- Budget and Resources
- Across the Gears: Collaborative Leadership

As of June 30th 2017, seventy-five (75) school districts have completed the District Assessment. A much smaller number have participated in the individual Gear Assessments that provide a deeper review of readiness Gear by Gear.

Wisconsin Data



The first section of this report aggregates the data from all of those school districts, per the Future Ready Privacy Policy that allows aggregated reports of all data collected on the Future Ready Dashboard. Thus, all 75 districts are represented.

The second section of this report provides detailed information on the sixty-five (65) districts that have signed a release form, allowing the Wisconsin Department of Education to access their data.

The spreadsheets that accompany this report provide Future Ready datasets for the 65 districts with signed data release forms allowing the Wisconsin DPI to access their data.

Section 1: Consolidated Digital Learning Report for Wisconsin


This first section includes a consolidated summary report representing the 75 schools that had participated in the Future Ready assessments as of June 30th, 2017.

District Assessments

District leadership teams participating in Future Ready initially meet together to discuss the questions on the district self-assessment, entering consensus responses. Those responses are consolidated into a 1-10 rating for each gear. The overall rating is the average across the gears ratings (see chart below).

The average district team assessment (DTA) score for the 75 Wisconsin school districts is 6.2 (of 10). The leading indicators of digital learning are Robust Infrastructure (7.6) and Data and Privacy (6.9), and the lagging indicators are Use of Space and Time (4.6), and Community Partnerships (5.7).

Figure 1: The average Digital Learning Ratings from the District Assessment across the 63 Wisconsin school district as of 6/30/17



Gear Assessments

Some of the Wisconsin 75 Districts also completed the more detailed Gear Assessments. Those are a separate set of 8 assessments (one for each Gear) offered to districts for participation by individuals selected by the district in order to gain multiple perspectives on the details of the Gear. Results are aggregated into Gear reports. The figure below compares the results from the aggregated Gear Assessments averaged across the districts that participated in those Gear assessments, versus the results from the District Assessment displayed above. It should be noted that the number of participating districts in the Gear Assessments is relatively low (See Table 1). Only 21 of the 75 districts took the individual Gear Assessments.

Based on the average scores from the Gear Assessment from the 20 participating districts, the leading indicators are Robust Infrastructure (7.2), Personalized Professional Learning (6.6), and Data & Privacy (6.6), whereas the lagging indicators are Budget and Resources (6.1), Curriculum, Instruction, and Assessment (6.2), and Use of Space and Time (6.2).

It is insightful to compare leading and lagging indicators based on average scores from the District Assessment versus the Gear Assessments. The District Assessment represents the consensus voice of the District Leadership Team whereas the Gear Assessment represents other stakeholder groups.
