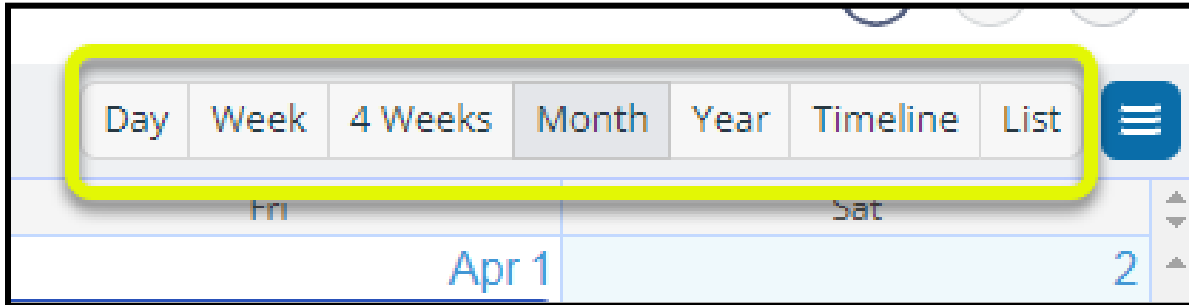

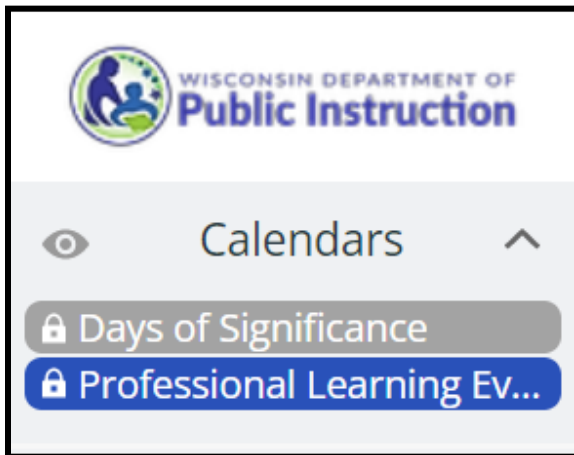


Select calendars to view (Top left of page)

The Wisconsin Libraries Professional Learning Calendar is made up of two sub-calendars: **Days of Significance** and **Professional Learning Events** (this is the main calendar).

Toggle the calendars on and off by clicking on the calendar name.

All calendars selected:

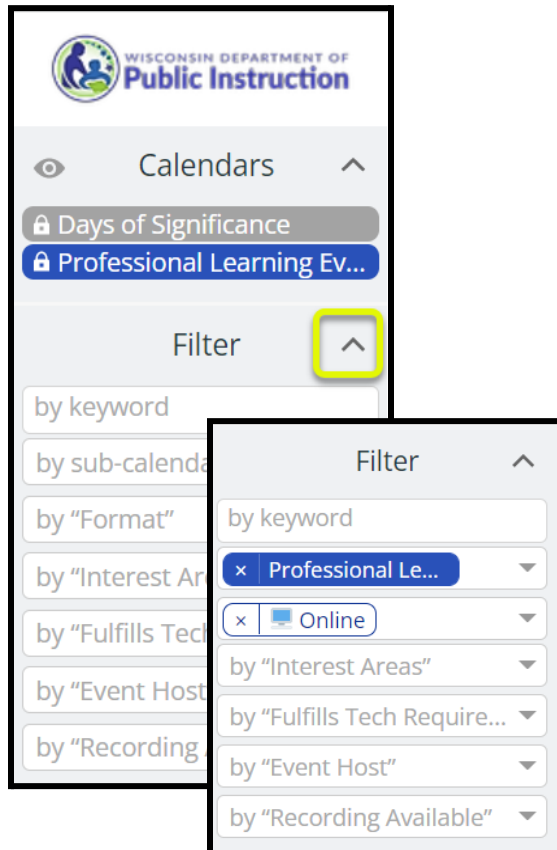


Days of Significance turned off:



Using the filters (Left column, click to expand)

A variety of filters are available to locate relevant professional learning. Click on the arrow to expand or hide filters.



- **Keyword** (click Enter to apply)
- **Format** (online, in-person, or hybrid)
- **Interest areas**
- By whether or not an event fulfills the **technology requirement** for public library director certification
- **Event host**
- By whether or not there is a **recording** available

To include more than one option for a filter (for example the Interest Areas *Leadership, Management & Governance AND Trustees, Friends, Foundations & Volunteers*), choose the first, then click the down arrow again to add more. **All** events that fit into any of the options selected will display. Clear your filters by clicking the red circle in the bottom right corner of the filter area. To save and revisit filters, click the "Get Link" icon in the bottom left corner of the filter area.

Using the search (Upper right corner of page)

For more advanced search options beyond using the Keyword filter:

1. Click on the magnifying glass icon in the upper right (in desktop view)
2. Enter your search term(s)
3. Update date range and check the box
4. Click Search
5. For even more advanced search tips from TeamUp, select *Search Guide*


