
EDUCATION

Vision: All students succeed academically and graduate high school, prepared for higher education, career and community.




INCOME

Formerly Incarcerated Individuals Face Even Bigger Challenges; We Can Help

Currently, Wisconsin's Recidivism Rate is 38%

- One of the primary causes for reincarceration is the inability to find and maintain work, housing, food, transportation, and basic needs.
- Not knowing where to turn in times of insecurity leads people back to the behaviors that led to their incarceration.
- Preconceived notions about former offenders often leads to difficulty in finding employment, the building block to address all other insecurities.
- They are often not open about their needs and internalize struggles.
- Incarceration is not a warehousing problem, it is a social problem we must all engage in if we are to affect any lasting change.






US Population Covered by 211







Additionally to resources related to COVID-19 (test sites, vaccines, general information on the disease), we provided the highest number of referrals to agencies that responded to rent needs (Porchlight, **Dane County Human Services, Tenant Resource Center and Community Action Coalition).**
