


Search Tips

Learn about the best way to search for information in the Wisconsin Digital Archives.



Simple Search:

Use the search box on the homepage.

Enter keywords and find documents on your topic of interest. This searches full-text of the document and the record describing the document.

Search Tip

The Simple Search matches the word as it appears in any context.

Searching for "beaver" will also return results about Beaver Dam as well as documents about the animal.



Search Tip

Not sure how the word ends? Use wildcard searching by putting * at the end of a word.

Searching for "Test*" will give you results for "test," "tests," "tested" etc.


Advanced Search:

Build a more specific search by searching part of the record that describes the document.

Search Tip

If you know what document you're looking for, use the Title search in the Adanced Search options.


- Select Title from the drop down
- Enter the keywords of the title
- Click Search




