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History and Purpose

History

1997 Wisconsin Act 298 created the statutory Professional Standards Council for Teachers (PSCT) to advise the state superintendent on policy matters in the areas of licensure, educator preparation, evaluation, and effective teaching.

Purpose

The council's purpose is to make recommendations to the state superintendent. The work of the council is advisory only and any recommendations are subject to approval by the State Superintendent. The areas the council may focus on are detailed in Wisconsin Statutes 115.425.

Statutory responsibilities also require an annual report to the appropriate standing legislative committees on the activities and effectiveness of the council and that the council meet at least two times per year.
