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## **Licensing Rule Proposals**

#### Statutory Requirement [118.19(3)]

...each student in the program is required to complete student teaching consisting of full days for a full semester following the daily schedule and semester calendar of the cooperating school or the equivalent, as determined by the state superintendent.

# PI 34.023 (2) (f) provides that each student shall have student teaching experience which lasts for one of the following durations:

- 1) for educator preparation programs leading to the student's first license, the student teaching shall be for full school days for a full semester of the cooperating school; or
- 2) for educator preparation programs leading to the student obtaining an additional teacher license, the student teaching shall be for a duration determined by the educator preparation program to be necessary for the student to gain the necessary clinical experience for the additional license.

The revisions include:

• Potential reduction to 15 weeks as equivalent.

OR

• Up to 10 days substitute teaching (with the appropriate license) in the cooperating teacher's classroom.
