My Mentoring History



- 2005 First year teacher,
 Janesville, WI
- 2007 transferred to McFarland
- 2010-11 first opportunity to mentor



History of McFarland Mentoring Program



- 2002 begin training mentors
- By 2006, 45 teachers had completed mentoring training through DCNTP
- Projected by August 2007, all team leaders complete mentoring training
- Provide mentors to veteran new colleagues
- Emphasis on improving practice, community and reflection

Current Mentoring Practices

- Part-time full release mentor (retired teacher)
- 1:1 mentors
- Most trained mentors paired with newest new teachers
- Continue to provide mentoring support to veteran new colleagues
- Differentiated level of expectation for mentors across years 1-3 and beyond
- Strong connection with DCNTP workshops and training

Next Steps

- Failed operational referendum on April 2nd
- Fewer new teachers and mentors next year
- Focus project
 - Summer 2022 defining mentoring expectations
 - Summer 2023 mentoring website
 - Summer 2024 planning monthly new teacher PD sessions
