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Three-Year Evaluation

Evaluation questions:

- 1) How do PRMG awardees structure mentoring and peer support?
- 2) How do PRMG programs reflect current research on effective mentoring practice?
- 3) How well do PRMG programs train and support mentors?
- 4) What is the impact of mentoring supported by PRMG on new teacher practice?



Evaluation Activities

Year 1 (2023)

Year 2 (2023-24)


- Survey on application process

Year 2 PRMG Interview Report



To learn about new teacher support, promising practices, and challenges.

Spoke with grant leads from

- 22 districts
- 12 CESAs



Key Findings

PRMG:

- Positively contributed to training development
- Enhances multiple areas of induction-related support

In addition:

Mentor role is evolving to include instructional coaching



Key Findings

- Different approaches to mentor training, many use DPI training resources
- Common challenges districts and CESAs face
- Respondents shared a number of opportunities for improvement
