Key Evaluation Questions

- **How do states and local grantees respond to federal requirements for serving migratory children?**
- **What services are provided to migratory students?**



Key Evaluation Questions

- **How do MEP grantees collaborate with other programs and agencies to address the needs of high mobile students?**
- **How do migrant programs support students in earning high school diplomas and equivalency, and preparing for post secondary education and the workforce?**



Study Methods

- Literature Review
- Analysis of Extant Data
- Survey of State Directors
- **Survey of Local Directors**
- Case studies of ten states, twenty schools districts, and forty schools or projects.



Survey of Local Directors

- OME intends to survey all grantees.
- OME will ask DPI for the names and contact information for local directors.
- Survey is scheduled to be sent during the Summer of 2017.
