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
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


ESSA State Plan Timeline

Migrant Components of State Plan

- Ensure the unique educational needs of migratory children
- Promote interstate and intrastate coordination of services
- State priorities for use of Title I, Part C funds

Key Evaluation Questions

- How do states and local grantees respond to federal requirements for serving migratory children?
- What services are provided to migratory students?



Key Evaluation Questions

- How do MEP grantees collaborate with other programs and agencies to address the needs of high mobile students?
- How do migrant programs support students in earning high school diplomas and equivalency, and preparing for post secondary education and the workforce?



Study Methods

- Literature Review
- Analysis of Extant Data
- Survey of State Directors
- Survey of Local Directors
- Case studies of ten states, twenty schools districts, and forty schools or projects.
