

Wisconsin Migrant Population Annual Report

The purpose of the population report is twofold:

- 1) To document the number of individuals identified by the department for coverage under Wis. Stat. 103.90-103.97.**
- 2) To document the labor needs filled by those individuals.**

The annual population of migrant workers, as expressed in this report, is the number of workers and their non-working family members identified by the department that come to Wisconsin to work in agriculture, horticulture or food processing for less than ten months each year. Included is the H-2A population.
