



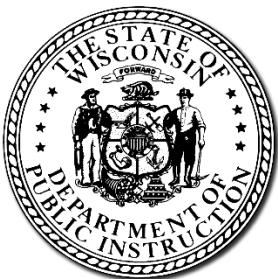
Proclamation
