To Whom it May Concern:

The Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction (WDPI) received the April 22, 2025 email from the U.S. Department of Education (USDE). On April 18, 2025, the WDPI provided USDE a letter certifying its compliance with all applicable statutory and regulatory requirements, including but not limited to Title VI of the Civil Rights Act (Title VI). By this letter, the WDPI again certifies its compliance. Attached to the WDPI's April 18 letter were the certified assurances of each of the 460 local educational agencies (LEAs) in the State of Wisconsin. Each LEA has provided its certified assurance of compliance with Title VI. The WDPI will communicate the information contained in the USDE's April 22, 2025 email directly to LEAs.

The WDPI reiterates that if the certified assurances referenced above are insufficient to meet the conditions of federal funding imposed by USDE, please articulate the basis in law for imposing these conditions, as well as an explanation as to why these assurances do not fulfill those requirements.
