

## MILWAUKEE PARENTAL CHOICE PROGRAM (MPCP)

### MPCP Facts and Figures for 2022-23 As of October 2022

In October 2022, there were 129 private schools participating in the MPCP, with a total enrollment of 28,958 students or 28,130.6 full-time equivalent (FTE) in the program.\* The 2022-23 MPCP state aid payment for a student enrolled full-time in the MPCP in grade kindergarten through eight is \$8,399 and \$9,045 for a student enrolled full-time in grade nine through twelve.

The program is estimated to cost \$240,861,400 in 2022-23. Beginning in the 2013-14 school year, the previous 38.4% aid reduction to MPS will be reduced by 3.2 percentage points per year until the program is fully funded by state general purpose revenue. In the 2022-23 school year the MPCP is funded 6.4% from a reduction in state general aid to MPS (\$15,415,100 in 2022-23) and 93.6% from state general purpose revenue (\$225,446,300 in 2022-23).

The table below shows the MPCP enrollment by grade level. The number of students listed in the table is reported by headcount and FTE. For example, a four-year-old kindergarten student may be counted as 0.5 or 0.6 FTE.
