Accreditation Information

This bulletin contains information on meeting the accreditation requirement under Wis. Stat. § 115.7915(2)(c) and Wis. Admin. Code § PI 49. Under Wis. Admin. Code § PI 49.03(6), the accreditation notice, from the accreditation agency, must be submitted by **August 1 annually** and may not be dated any earlier than July 1 of that school year. If the school is also participating in the Private School Choice Programs, one notice may be submitted to the Department for the school.

The DPI will work directly with the accrediting agencies to obtain the accreditation notice. Schools are responsible for ensuring they are fully accredited by their accrediting agencies and are included in the notice, by reaching out to their accrediting agency. The accreditation notice must be completed by an authorized member of the accrediting agency and include all of the following information:

- The private school's name;
- The private school's address for each location included in the accreditation;
- The grades accredited; and
- Indication that the private school is accredited at the time the notice is filed.

The grades that a Special Needs Scholarship Program (SNSP) school is accredited for must include all of the grades available for SNSP students as indicated on the Intent to Participate and, if applicable, any additional grades added in the SNSP Portal through the School Information Update Form: SNSP Scholarships and Grades Available. A SNSP school cannot have SNSP students in grades that it is not fully accredited for by a statutorily approved accreditation agency.

If a school is not fully accredited for all grades available for SNSP students, it must:

- 1) File a SNSP Private School Requirements Form and all required attachments with the DPI by the first weekday in March in advance of the school year the school will participate in the SNSP; and
- 2) Be approved as a private school by the state superintendent by August 1.

A school that meets both of the above requirements is not required to meet the accreditation requirements for the SNSP.
