RE: 2023-2024 Misreported Roster Data to WISEdash

During the review of the Sun Prairie East and Sun Prairie West Report Card, 2024-25, we realized that the data on pages 8 and 9, Postsecondary Preparation information and Arts Course Information 2023-24, data is reporting incorrectly. As part of our commitment to transparency and accuracy, we believe it is essential to promptly address these discovered discrepancies.

After conducting a comprehensive review, we noted that grades data was not submitted for Sun Prairie West High School in Roster Data Snapshot for December 2023. We also discovered that incomplete grades data was submitted for Sun Prairie East High School in the Roster Data Snapshot for December 2023. As part of our review, we have updated the two areas within the Report Card, 2024-25 for both Sun Prairie East High School and Sun Prairie West High School. You will note that the data items in yellow indicate amended data.

Please accept this letter as official notification of the data error.
