I'm taking the time to do this **AGAIN** in 2025 like I had to in 2024 & 2022 as the DPI **AGAIN** did not correctly download our 2024 TFS economically disadvantaged numbers for AGR purposes with their December 2024 snapshot. We had the correct numbers in Infinite Campus. We had this same issue last year and three years ago and I discussed this with _____ at DPI at the time.

The DPI has our 2024 TFS economically disadvantaged in grades K-3 at 63 students.

Our actual 2024 TFS economically disadvantaged in grades K-3 was 79.

Our economically disadvantaged in the Elem was 135, the MS was 56 and the HS was 62.

The number of economically disadvantaged students frequently changes throughout the school year. The DPI was first trying to tell me that the December snapshot captures the TFS data, which I argued was incorrect. It was eventually reported to me that I was correct.

I received the following from _____ DPI on November 16, 2022 at 8:00 a.m. *"I was corrected by the WISEdash team - the snapshot captures the most recent food service record submitted in WISEdata, not necessarily the record over the TFS date. So whatever food service data is submitted and current in WISEdata when the Snapshot happens on Dec 6th, is what will be captured and reported."*

I don't know why the DPI had to change the reporting method for AGR purposes, but they made it more difficult than easier. Hopefully they get it corrected for next year, **which has not happened for four years.**

Very irritated and frustrated **AGAIN** having to waste my time because the DPI can not get their systems accurate!
