Category: December Snapshot Economically Disadvantaged Students

During the review of the December 2024 Snapshot report. We noted some errors that came to our attention. As part of our commitment to transparency and accuracy, we believe it is essential to address any discrepancies discovered promptly.

After conducting a comprehensive review, we discovered that our percentage of Economically Disadvantaged Students was off by 51.61%. The December Snapshot shows we have an Economically Disadvantaged Percentage of 1.79% when it should be 53.40% for the entire district. The correct Individual School Economically Disadvantaged statuses are as follows: Necedah Elementary is 61.48%, NVision Learning Center is 42.86%, Necedah Middle School is 53%, Necedah High School is 47.48%, and NGage Academy is 53.13%. This year we qualified for CEP and the way we needed to enter our Economically Disadvantaged students into our SIS changed. We show that a total of 353 students out of 661 total student enrollment should have qualified as Economically Disadvantaged. We have corrected this in our SIS for all students who qualified as Economically Disadvantaged.

December Snapshot Economically Disadvantaged Student Percentage shows 1.79% District wide. Actual Economically Disadvantaged Student Percentage is 53.40% District, Necedah Elementary is 61.48%, NVision Learning Center is 42.86%, Necedah Middle is 53%, Necedah High is 47.48% and NGage Academy is 53.13%.
