

Out-of-School Time Programs



Support for Students

Over 121,000 Wisconsin students participate in out-of-school time (OST) programs, and the majority of these students are economically disadvantaged. OST programs build out academic supports beyond the school day and assist social emotional well-being.

Grant Funding

The department is requesting \$20 million beginning in FY23 to provide grant support for OST programs. Currently 80% of federal OST funds are spent at the elementary school level. This state-funded proposal would focus on middle and high school settings, while furthering the reach of OST programming to elementary programs.
