The EAGS, administered by the East Asian Library of the University of Pittsburgh University Library System, focuses on free delivery of full-text Chinese academic publications to researchers.

[The Free Library](#)

The Free Library has free, full-text versions of classic literary works. Recently, The Free Library has been expanded to include publications covering Business and Industry, Communications, Entertainment, Health, Humanities, Law, Government, Politics, Recreation and Leisure, Science and Technology, and Social Sciences. This collection includes millions of articles dating back to 1984 as well as newly-published articles that are added to the site daily.

Genamics JournalSeek is a categorized database of freely available journal information. Journal information includes the description (aims and scope), journal abbreviation, journal homepage link, subject category and ISSN. This site is very helpful for locating complete journal titles from citation abbreviations and will provide a link to the journal website. Often, some articles are made freely available on the journal's website.

Through Google's Library project, books in the public domain are available in "full view" and free for download. For in-print books where permission has been granted, the number of viewable pages is limited to a "preview" set.
