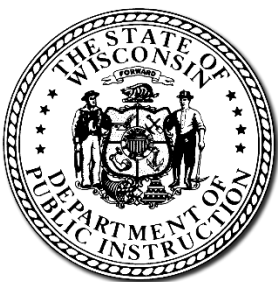


National School Breakfast Week

- WHEREAS: The School Nutrition Association has designated March 3-7, 2025, National School Breakfast Week; and
- WHEREAS: The School Breakfast Program plays a vital role in promoting the health and educational development of children across our state by ensuring nutritious and balanced breakfasts are accessible in Wisconsin schools, helping to set a strong foundation for learning and well-being; and
- WHEREAS: Currently, 2,074 schools across Wisconsin participate in the School Breakfast Program. During the 2023-24 school year, the program served more than 35 million nutritious meals to students in Wisconsin; and
- WHEREAS: Children who eat breakfast are more likely to score better on standardized tests, maintain a healthy diet, improve concentration and memory, and achieve greater success in subjects like reading and math; and
- WHEREAS: According to the School Nutrition Association, the School Breakfast Program provides 12 million nutritious breakfasts to hungry children across the country each day;
