



Smart Snacks Updates

- As of July 1, 2016:
 - Sodium limit for snacks is now 200 mg (previously 230 mg)
 - The fourth General Standard (about a product meeting 10% of the daily value of certain nutrients of public health concern) has gone away

Smart Snacks Updates, continued

- Final Rule – released July 29, 2016
 - Whole eggs with no added fat are now exempt from the total and saturated fat standards
 - Canned vegetables that are low-sodium or no-salt added with no added fat are exempt from all nutrient standards
 - Added “main dish” clarification to entrée definition
 - Still able to comment on the total fat standard (until September 27, 2016)






