USDA Memos

- **SP34-2015: Fresh Fruit and Vegetable Program: Allocation of Funds for School Year 2015-2016**
- WI is being funded for another year of FFVP grants. We will be receiving \$3,317,564 which is \$38,136 more than last year.



USDA Memos

- **SP 35-2015: Community Eligibility Provision: Revised Department of Education Title I Guidance**
- This guidance memo is to let us know that the Department of Education updated their guidance titled "The Community Eligibility Provision and Selected Requirements Under Title I, Part A of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965, as amended." in March 2015, replacing the January 2014 guidance.

FY14 USDA Equipment Grant Awards

- 23 SFA's have been notified that they received awards.
- All have above 50% of students eligible for free and reduced meals.
- A mix of public, private and charter schools in urban, rural and suburban schools throughout Wisconsin have received equipment funding.
- The oldest equipment replacement we were able to fund are dish machines that are 42 & 50 years old and a steamer that is 46 years old.




- The new record retention length is 3 years plus the current year
