

MILWAUKEE PARENTAL CHOICE PROGRAM (MPCP)

MPCP Facts and Figures for 2020-21 As of October 2020

In October 2020, there were 131 private schools participating in the MPCP, with a total enrollment of 28,583 students or 27,805.7 full-time equivalent (FTE) in the program.* The 2020-21 MPCP state aid payment for a student enrolled full-time in the MPCP in grade kindergarten through eight is \$8,300 and \$8,946 for a student enrolled full-time in grade nine through twelve.

The program is estimated to cost \$234,195,000 in 2020-21. Beginning in the 2013-14 school year, the previous 38.4% aid reduction to MPS will be reduced by 3.2 percentage points per year until the program is fully funded by state general purpose revenue. In the 2020-21 school year the MPCP is funded 12.8% from a reduction in state general aid to MPS (\$29,977,000 in 2020-21) and 87.2% from state general purpose revenue (\$204,218,000 in 2020-21).

The table below shows the MPCP enrollment by grade level. The number of students listed in the table is reported by headcount and FTE. For example, a four-year-old kindergarten student may be counted as 0.5 or 0.6 FTE.
