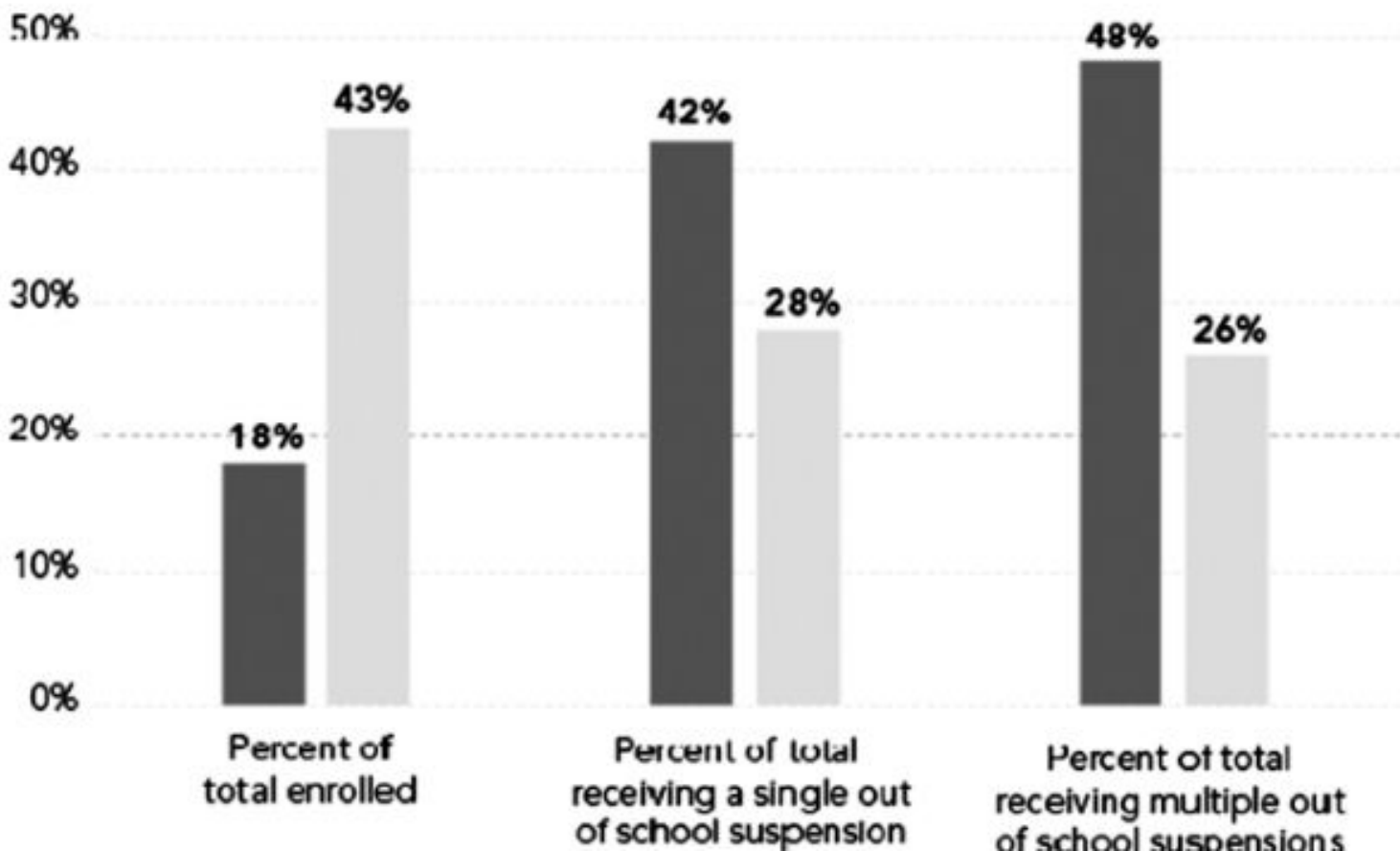

For discipline to be most effective, it must happen within the context of a relationship of an adult and child who have a trusted/connected relationship.

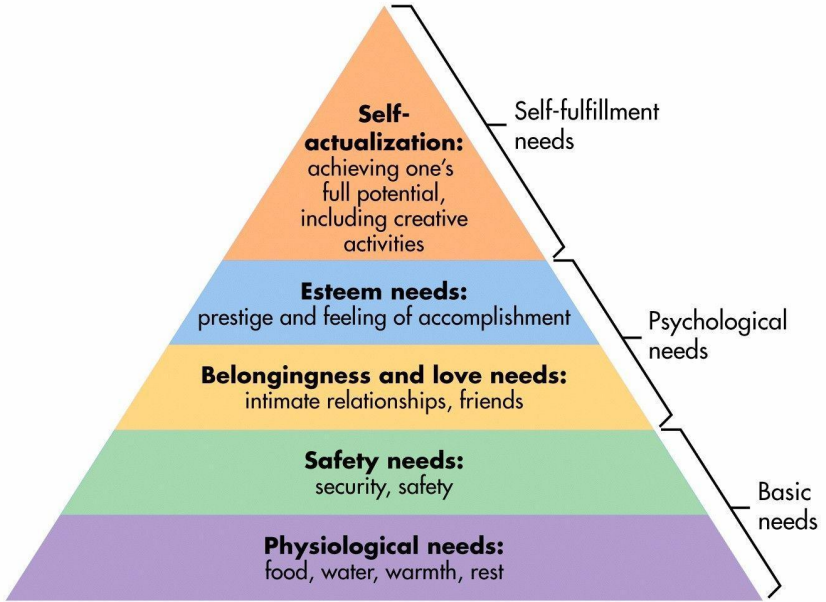
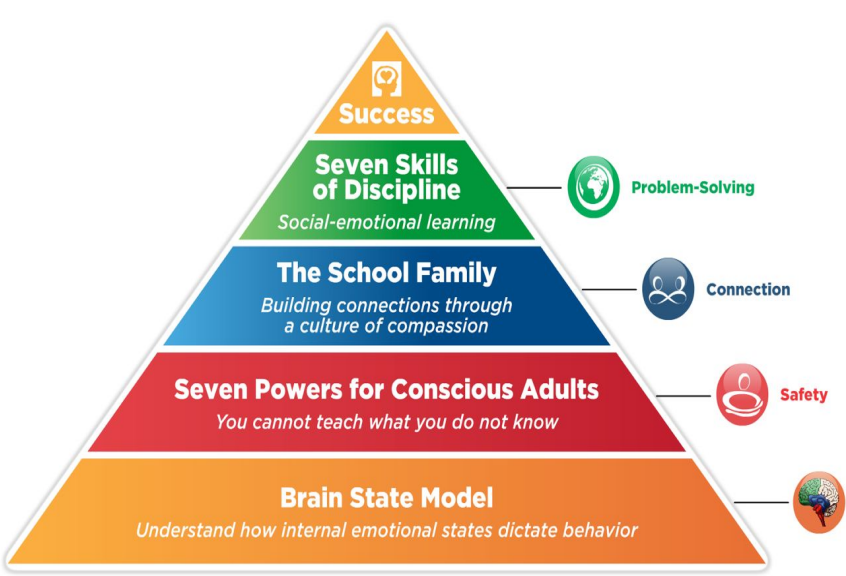
