River Valley School District	Remodel an existing middle school storage facility area into a conference room to use for IEP meetings.	\$3,781.00	\$3,781.00
Prairie du Chien Area School District	Resurface playgrounds at two schools with rubber material to enable students in wheelchairs access to equipment and add new accessible playground equipment.	\$199,994.00	\$199,994.00
Brillion School District	Enhance previous remodeling project by replacing flooring with suitable materials to offer a safe environment for students with disabilities and repair wall damaged during prior ARRA project.	\$12,321.00	\$12,321.00
Bonduel School District	Install playground equipment for students with disabilities, including an adapted swing, sand area, and an area for play with students without disabilities.	\$5,000.00	\$5,000.00

Erin School District	Add an accessible door to the principal's office to afford access for student's with physical disabilities.	\$4,763.00	\$4,763.00
Madison Metropolitan School District	Install a double doorway between two classrooms for EBD students to reduce unsafe behaviors during transitions by limiting movement within the classrooms. More flexible grouping of students and staff supporting these students also will result.	\$5,000.00	\$5,000.00
Madison Metropolitan School District	Replace a glass chalk board with a whiteboard. Students attending this program often have volatile behaviors. The replacement offers a safer environment.	\$1,100.00	\$1,100.00
