Facts related to the above matter were determined by the State Superintendent of Public Instruction by conferences held, at the State Superintendent's direction, by V. E. Kimball, Assistant State Superintendent, with the appellant, Gilbert J. V [REDACTED]; Clyde E. Sheets, Attorney for Gilbert J. V [REDACTED]; teachers and administrators of the South Milwaukee School System; and with Attorney Richard P. Rouse, City Attorney of the City of South Milwaukee.

Attempts were made by the Assistant State Superintendent to secure readmittance of Neal V [REDACTED] to the South Milwaukee Junior-Senior High School without benefit of the making and filing of a formal order by the State Superintendent. These efforts were not successful and resulted in the securing of statements of intent on the part of the appellant and the representatives of the South Milwaukee City School System that in the event of a filing of an order, which either upheld the order of expulsion or set such order of expulsion aside, appeal would be taken to the courts.

In view of the failure to secure a compromise, the State Superintendent held a hearing on the appeal.

Information secured having established to the satisfaction of the State

Superintendent that Noel V [REDACTED] did act in violation of rules established by the Board of Education of the South Milwaukee School System, and that the Board of Education did act within the limitations of its legal authority to expel, the appeal filed by Gilbert J. V [REDACTED] is hereby and herewith dismissed subject to the condition that the order of expulsion of Noel V [REDACTED] is considered by the State Superintendent of Public Instruction to have applied only to the 1960/61 school year and to the further condition that Noel V [REDACTED] will be eligible to enroll in the South Milwaukee High School for the year 1961/62.
