

This letter will confirm several telephone calls I have had this past day with various persons involved with the appeal of April 6th expulsion decision of the Unified School District of Antigo.

Since the appeal, Joseph has been brought into Juvenile Court and has been placed in a home away from Antigo. Our best guess is that he will be returning to the Unified School District of Antigo no sooner than September, 1979; and, I am informed by the School Superintendent and the school attorney that with proper notice all steps necessary for his re-admission will be expedited to the best interests of Joe.

Therefore, I do not feel that it is in the best interests of Joseph to continue with our appeal of the expulsion decision. Would you please use this letter as your authority to dismiss the appeal without prejudice; and, please notify us and the school board so that we may close our files on this matter.
