IT IS THEREFORE THE PRELIMINARY ORDER OF THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION: That both appellants be forthwith admitted to attendance at Marshall High School with all the rights and privileges attendant thereto pending a final determination on the merits of their individual appeals.
