THE NATURE OF THE CASE



By letter to appellant's counsel, dated August 13, 1982, I requested that appellant submit written arguments on the merits of her appeal by August 27, 1982. In a letter dated September 1, 1982, appellant's counsel requested an extension of 30 days to submit written arguments; however, no further communication has been received.

On December 20, 1982, a letter was sent to appellant's counsel by certified mail informing him that this appeal would be dismissed for failure to prosecute pursuant to the provisions of Wis. Admin. Code PI 1.07 if a response was not received within 20 days. Having received no response,
