
THE NATURE OF THE CASE

This is an appeal to the State Superintendent of Public Instruction pursuant to sec. 120.13(1)(c), Wis. Stats., from the November 3, 1982 decision of the Westosha School Board expelling the appellant, James M. B. [REDACTED], from school until the beginning of the 1983-84 school year. The appeal was filed on November 11, 1982. An interim decision and order denying appellant's motion for reinstatement pending final determination of the appeal was issued on December 22, 1982. That Order directed that the appellant's brief or statement as to the merits of the appeal was to be served and filed no later than January 5, 1983. However, no brief or statement regarding the merits of the appeal has been received.

On February 1, 1983, a letter was sent to appellant's parents advising them that this appeal would be dismissed for failure to prosecute pursuant to the provisions of Wis. Admin. Code PI 1.07 if a response was not received within 20 days. Having received no response:

THIS APPEAL IS HEREBY DISMISSED.
