

NATURE OF THE APPEAL

This is an appeal to the State Superintendent of Public Instruction pursuant to Wis. Stat. §120.13(1)(c). This appeal was initiated by Mrs. Michael W [REDACTED], Sr., mother of Michael W [REDACTED], Jr., (Michael) by letter dated August 22, 1984. In a response dated September 28, 1984 the Boyceville Community School District (School District) argued, inter alia, that inasmuch as Michael was eighteen (18) years old on August 22, 1984, he was required by Wis. Stat. §120.13(1)(c) to file an appeal in his own name and that the appeal filed by his parent was procedurally defective. By certified letter dated October 16, 1984 the State Superintendent directed that evidence of Michael's age on August 22, 1984 be provided and that, if Michael was eighteen (18) years old on said date, Michael submit an appeal in his own name in accordance with §120.13(1)(c), Wis. Stats., and within twenty (20) days in accordance with PI 1.07 (1)(a). Having obtained evidence that Michael was eighteen years old on August 22, 1984 and having received no appeal or response from Michael within twenty days (20) days,

THIS APPEAL IS HEREBY DISMISSED.
