

NATURE OF THE APPEAL

This is an appeal to the State Superintendent of Public Instruction pursuant to Wis. Stat. s. 120.13(1)(c). This appeal was initiated by Mr. John P [REDACTED], father of Justin Bryan P [REDACTED] (Jay), by letter dated April 22, 1986. In the letter of appeal, Mr. P [REDACTED] indicates that he does not contest the facts and believes that Jay was rightfully expelled. Having received no response from Mr. P [REDACTED] or Jay regarding any intent to proceed with the appeal after receipt of the letter from the Department of Public Instruction dated May 15, 1986, and inasmuch as there is no controversy of the facts and that all procedural requirements of s. 120.13(1)(c), Wis. Stats., were duly met, there is no basis for an appeal.

THIS APPEAL IS HEREBY DISMISSED.
