This is an appeal to the State Superintendent of Public Instruction pursuant to s. 120.13(1)(c), Wis. Stats., from the May 18, 1987 decision of the Amery School District Board of Education to discipline Anthony Clark K██████████ by suspending him from school for part of May 1987 and September 1987, by placing him on social probation for the 1987 fall semester and by placing him on general probation for the remainder of the 1987-88 school year. Social probation includes placing certain restrictions on Anthony Clark K██████████, including restricting him from participating in athletic or after-school activities.

The immediate matter before the State Superintendent is the appellant's request that an immediate order be entered against the school board prohibiting the board from implementing any portion of its May 18, 1987 order while this appeal is pending.


In light of the fact that Anthony will be receiving instruction during the September suspension and that a final decision in this matter will be reached within the next

three to four weeks, I find that the appellant will not suffer any irreparable harm while the appeal is pending.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that appellant's request for an order prohibiting the board from implementing any portion of its May 18, 1987 order while this appeal is pending is hereby denied.
