DECISION AND ORDER

94/95-EX-20

Nature of the Appeal

This is an appeal to the State Superintendent of Public Instruction pursuant to sec. 120.13(1)(c), Wis. Stats., from the action of the Whitewater School District Board of Education to expel Omar C [REDACTED] from the Whitewater School District effective June 1, 1995. This appeal was filed on behalf of the pupil by Attorney Edward Kraus of Legal Action of Wisconsin, Inc., and was received by the Department of Public Instruction on June 29, 1995.

In light of communications from Attorney Kraus, counsel for the pupil, it is no longer necessary to process this appeal further. Accordingly I make the following findings and conclusions.

Findings of Fact

1. The Department received the above referenced appeal letter from Attorney Kraus on June 29, 1995.

2. On June 29, 1995 the Department sent a letter acknowledging receipt of the appeal to Attorney Kraus and District Administrator John Negley.
3. By letter dated July 31, 1995, Attorney Edward Kraus, on behalf of the pupil, advised the Department that the pupil and the District reached an amicable settlement and requested that the appeal of the expulsion be withdrawn with prejudice.


Conclusions of Law

2. The expulsion appeal is withdrawn by Attorney Kraus, counsel for the pupil.
