Nature of the Appeal

This is an appeal to the State Superintendent of Public Instruction pursuant to sec. 120.13(1)(c), Wis. Stats., from the action of the to expel Carol T. [REDACTED] from the Central/Westosha School District Board of Education effective October 29, 1997. This appeal was filed on behalf of the pupil by Jon Mason, and was received by the Department of Public Instruction on December 1, 1997.

In light of communications from Jon Mason, counsel for Carol T. [REDACTED], it is no longer necessary to process this appeal further. Accordingly I make the following findings and conclusions.

Findings of Fact

1. The Department received the above referenced appeal letter from Jon Mason on December 1, 1997.
2. On December 2, 1997 the Department sent a letter acknowledging receipt of the appeal to Jon Mason and District Administrator Gerald Sorensen.

3. By letter dated January 5, 1998, Attorney Jon Mason, on behalf of the pupil, advised the Department that an agreement had been reached between the parties to grant the pupil a new expulsion hearing. Therefore, the pupil's appeal was withdrawn.


Conclusions of Law
