NATURE OF THE APPEAL

This is an appeal to the State Superintendent of Public Instruction pursuant to sec. 120.13(1)(c), Wis. Stats., from the June 9, 1999 order of the Brown Deer School District Board of Education to expel the above named pupil from the Brown Deer School District through the 2002-2003 school year. This appeal was filed by the pupil's attorney and was received by the Department of Public Instruction on July 12, 1999.

On July 26, 1999, the Department of Public Instruction received written notification that the pupil's attorney, on behalf of the pupil, wished to withdraw his request for an appeal.

Findings of Fact

1. The Department received the above referenced appeal letter from the pupil's attorney, Thomas Kasen, on July 12, 1999.
2. On July 12, 1999 the Department sent a letter acknowledging receipt of the appeal to Attorney Kasen and District Administrator Bruce Connolly.

3. By letter dated July 23, 1999, Attorney Kasen, on behalf of the pupil, advised the Department that he wished to withdraw his appeal. Therefore, the pupil's appeal was withdrawn.


Conclusions of Law

2. Attorney Kasen, attorney for Tommie, withdrew the expulsion appeal.
