DECISION AND ORDER

Appeal No.: 00/01 EX 16

NATURE OF THE APPEAL

This is an appeal to the State Superintendent of Public Instruction pursuant to Wis. Stats. § 120.13(1)(c) from the order of the Marshfield School District Board of Education to expel the above-named pupil from the Marshfield School District. This appeal was filed by the pupil and received by the Department of Public Instruction on July 5, 2001.


On August 9, 2001, the school board, by its attorney, notified the State Superintendent that the district did not provide sufficient notice of the expulsion hearing to Nicole. The board, therefore, rescinded the order of expulsion. The board also indicated that any future expulsion proceeding regarding Nicole will comply with all applicable procedural requirements.

As the expulsion has been rescinded, this appeal is moot. *See Travis O. v. Lake Geneva-Genoa City Union School District Board of Education*, Decision and Order No. 370 (August 21, 1998); *Christopher D. v. Hartland Lakeside Joint No. 3 School District Board of Education*, Decision and Order No. 270 (January 18, 1996); *Sheryl T. v. Winter School District Board of Education*, Decision and Order No. 245 (March 6, 1995).

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the appeal of the expulsion of Nicole P. D by
the Marshfield School District Board of Education is dismissed.
