

This is an appeal to the State Superintendent of Public Instruction pursuant to Wis. Stats. § 120.13(1)(c) from the order of the Marshall School District Board of Education to expel the above-named pupil from the Marshall School District. The pupil was expelled by order of the school board on January 31, 2008. This appeal was filed by the pupil and received by the Department of Public Instruction on February 19, 2008.

On March 13, 2008, the department received a letter from District Administrator, Barb Sramek, from the Marshall School District indicating the district made a procedural error when providing notice of the hearing to the pupil and the pupil's parent(s). The letter also indicated that the district intends to cure this error by rescheduling the hearing.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the expulsion issued by the by the school board on
January 31, 2008 of by the Marshall School District Board of Education is
reversed.
