Step 1 - Coordinate, Review and Register

Step 2 - Assess

In this step, you will complete two assessment tools. Our award will use the Action for Healthy Kids Platform (AFHK). Step 3 - Plan

As a team, examine your assessment results, recommendations, review other school data, and consider the needs of the school. Examine the school's strengths and opportunities to improve. When the team is determining which area(s) to focus on improvements, examine if there are opportunities to align efforts with the school's continuous improvement goal(s), brainstorm and research initiatives/activities to implement and then establish next steps. During this step, seek out and consider student and community input.
